

GUIDELINES FOR OBTAINING CLASSIFIABLE THUMBPRINTS

1. Thumbprints are recorded on the form by first applying printer's ink to the thumbs. This is accomplished by rolling the thumb on a fingerprint ink pad from one side of the thumb to the other side of the thumb
2. Roll the thumb from edge to edge and below the first crease line, use moderate pressure, and roll it one time only, and in one direction only – not back and forth with the tip pointing towards the top of the form..
3. Be sure the correct print is recorded in the proper block.
4. The ridges of the thumbprint must be distinct and clear. If the print is smudged or blurred, reprint.
