

# Distribution of the Hazardous Substance Information Survey

The Office of State Fire Marshal's Community Right to Know Unit annually sends out Hazardous Substance Information Surveys beginning in February and ending in September. The survey mailings are staggered based on which county the facility is located in. If a company has numerous facilities throughout the state of Oregon, they have the option to have all surveys mailed at once by submitting a request in writing to the Office of State Fire Marshal.
