



OREGON LIFE SAFETY TEAM PURPOSE, ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1) PURPOSE

To coordinate and implement consistent statewide fire prevention education.

2) ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

a) Office of State Fire Marshal

- i) Facilitate meetings and coordinate team activities.
- ii) Provide data for decision-making and evaluation.
- iii) Coordinate and implement consistent statewide fire prevention messages, campaigns and model programs.
- iv) Research, develop, facilitate, promote and support fire prevention education-related messages, campaigns, and model programs.
- v) Promote unique materials and programs shared by other team members.

b) Association and Partner Representatives

- i) Represent their association or partner interest.
- ii) Share information about team activities with association or partners.
- iii) Report to association board or partners on Life Safety Team activities.
- iv) Gain support of association board or partners for endorsement and promotion of team activities.
- v) Provide report of association or partner decision on endorsement and promotion of team activities at Life Safety Team meetings.
- vi) Foster improved fire prevention education collaboration among Oregon fire departments, fire service organizations and associations, and partners.

c) Regional Representatives

- i) Represent the fire departments in their region.
- ii) Share information about team activities with fire departments and partners in their region.
- iii) Gain support and involvement of fire department and community partners' in carrying out campaigns, model projects or distribution of messages.
- iv) Provide feedback and evaluation information to the Life Safety Team regarding activities completed in their region.
- v) Solicit input on team activities from their region.
- vi) Share unique materials and programs from fire departments in their region as a resource for other departments.
