Oregon Fire Bridge™, the new web-based incident reporting system, will be available for use as of January 1, 2010. In each free 5 hour "Train the Trainer" session, you'll learn to navigate the new reporting program. We advise each department to send one representative

who will then serve as the trainer when they return to their home department. The training is located regionally throughout the state of Oregon.

What will I learn?

- How to enter Fire, Juvenile, Hazmat, and other incident information.
- Gather the data importing tools to learn to upload your own third party vendor information into the state database.
- Gain familiarity with the software and learn new Oregon standards and reporting requirements which include an introduction to National Fire Information Reporting System (NFIRS) codes.
- Learn how to set up favorites to make this system unique to your department to make data entry easy.
- Establish standard and custom report writing skills within Oregon Fire Bridge

How do I sign up?

You must pre-register for the class by emailing claire.mcgregor@state.or.us with the following information:

- Date and Location of class in which you would like to participate.

As the training gets closer, you'll receive more information including classroom location and directions to get to the training location.

Who Should Attend?

This statewide training is a train-the-trainer session. A designated individual from each department should attend the training to learn new system requirements and gain access to Oregon Fire Bridge™ mandated for use January 1, 2010. Due to limited computer resources, we ask that one person per department sign up first, and any additional personnel that would like to attend will be placed on a waiting list until it can be verified that there is enough room for additional people.

Why Should I attend?

- The existing OAIRS system will no longer be available after 12/31/2009.

- The new system will require department setup from your department administrator.
- This system is provided free.
- Each participant will receive their user name and password for access to Oregon Fire Bridge™. Additional resources and tools for use with the system will also be handed out in class.
- Rollout instructions will be provided so you're ready for January 1, 2010.
