Step 1

Complete the OSFM courses: Basic Fire Investigation 100 and Basic Fire Investigation 200.
Complete four modules of fire investigation related training on the IAAI web site

Step 2

Apply to PCC for admission and obtain a student number. There is no fee for admission.

Complete the top portion of a PCC registration form. Remember to sign the form.
