AGENCY UPDATE

The Oregon state course dates will be April 13-15 and there will be no cost to attend since lodging, meals and travel will be covered. The course is 2 ½ days of hands on radioactive training. Ken will forward photos from the spent nuclear fuel shipments that occurred in June from Oregon State University.

UPCOMING TRAINING

Tanker truck railcar emergency training is still being worked out and should be ready to go around October or November. The training will be held at Chemeketa or Eugene Fire Department. When everything is finished Steve will get flyers out to everyone.
