## GUEST SPEAKER – BRIAN MAHONEY, OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY



Brian Mahoney has been with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division for the past eight years, and is the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Liaison for six counties in Northwest Oregon, where he provides oversight and technical assistance to county health departments' preparedness programs. He has had lead responsibility for coordinating discrete projects, such as the Hospital Bioterrorism Preparedness Program, CHEMPACK, Strategic National Stockpile, Emergency Healthcare Volunteer Registry, and Cities Readiness Initiative. Mr. Mahoney worked for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for 15 years as a Public Health Advisor in communicable disease control and bioterrorism preparedness programs. He also worked overseas with the World Health Organization for two years on the Polio Eradication Initiative. Mr. Mahoney was a Peace Corps Volunteer and served in Kenya from 1983 to 1985 working with rural villagers on water and sanitation, and community development projects. He earned a Masters of Public Health degree in management science from Emory University. He was elected a member of the Delta Omega Society, a national honorary public health society.
