LARRY RAAF

Larry Raaf is a native Oregonian and graduate of Oregon State University. He was commissioned into the US Army and served on active duty in Germany, Iran and California. He remained a member of the Army Reserve, and has completed assignments in Japan, Korea, the Philippines, Bosnia, and most recently, Afghanistan.

Upon release from active military duty in 1984, Larry accepted a position as Director of the 9-1-1 / Emergency Communications Agency for Marion County, Oregon.

In 1990 he moved to the Oregon State Emergency Management Division, managing the Oregon Emergency Response System (OERS). OERS is the oldest state-level emergency system in the nation, coordinating response to all hazards which threaten the state.

In 2000, Larry transferred to the Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal and served as a Hazardous Materials Planner and Fire Service Liaison. He also served as a Team Leader for the State Fire Marshal Emergency Response Center (ERC).

In 2002 he accepted a position with the Office of Security and Emergency Management, Bonneville Power Administration (US Dept of Energy). Larry served as the Continuity of Operations Project Manager and the Emergency Management Team Leader.

In November 2007 Larry began service with the Oregon Judicial Department managing the Security and Emergency Preparedness Office.

Larry also holds a masters degree from Lewis and Clark College (Public Administration). He is certified by the State of Oregon in Emergency Management and Search and Rescue and nationally certified in Business Continuity Planning. He is currently completing a Masters degree in Criminal Justice at Western Oregon University.

His military awards include the Bronze Star, Combat Action Badge and Expert Field Medical Badge
