Gary was hired in September 1979 as a helper/trainer. In March of 1980 he was promoted to a pipefitter and later that year as Construction Inspector. From January of 1982 to 1986 he served as Construction Inspector for the removal of a low pressure facility at Central Service, high pressure mains in subdivisions and rebuild of 20 houseboat marina's gas facility. From 1986-91 he worked in the Engineering department as a technical writer and advocated for writing the Oregon Dig Law and eventually getting the law approved through legislation. Gary spent 1991 to 2003 as Engineering Supervisor in the Salem District. June 2003 to present he serves as Damage Prevention Manager with two full time employees responsible for reduction of third party damages to NW Natural facilities companywide. He chaired the first One Call Board 1995-1997 and remained on One Call board for 14 years retiring in 2009.
