Communications:

- Immediate notification to public of evacuation or shelter in place as well as who's okay – schools
 - Red Cross for assistance
 - ORHAN
 - Reverse 9-1-1
 - Public Address
 - PIO's – Agencies

Public Safety:

- Initial dispatch ☞ fire/EMS (Battalion Chief)
 - Response Time 2 – 3 minutes on scene
 - 10 minutes initialize plan – scene size up
- Command
 - Initial Albany Fire 15 minutes
 - Unified Command
 - Law
 - Fire
 - Rail Road
 - Industry
- Notifications – Immediate
 - Samaritan Albany General ☞ Pt care/transport to
 - ? when will alerts to industries be made
 - Time frames (message preptime (consider 30 – 60 minutes))
 - Perimeters established
 - Identify notification to immediate areas
 - (Info) Hospital decon capability
- Command Structure
 - Perimeter establish
 - Evacuation Area
 - Rescue – immediate danger
 - Notification process
 - Affected community/buildings
 - Regulatory – ORS, ODOT, Public Works and resources
 - Initialize EOC/ECC to stand by and be ready
 - Lock down - control assess – decon standby (command post)

- Resources (county, hospital, ODOT, 9-1-1, HazMat) – command – traffic control
 - Internal Staffing
 - Attempt mitigation – Chemical release
 - Dispatch H.M. Liaison to hospital
 - More staff
- Industry:
 - External communications w/employees
 - Encourage stay at work
 - Release if needed
 - Kids school pickup
 - (?) Hazardous Material industries
 - Do employees know how to train for shelter in place
- Community Partners:
 - Cross jurisdictional communications
 - How will be affected – how to help
 - 9-1-1 we prioritize communications
 - Industry – improve community shelter in place during community outreach – fairs, etc

Public Safety

- Who decides evac/shelter in place
 - Command – unified/ fire department
- Notifications
 - ODOT 511 – trip check 1610 – 1650 radio
 - 911 – reverse
 - PA System
 - Personal Contact
- Whom
 - Joint info center (JIC)
 - Social media
- What was determining factor...Fire department
 - 20 PPM Red - Evacuation
 - 02 PPM Orange – Shelter in Place

Public Health

- Work with media ☞ health concerns
- Use of JIC
- Establish command structure

Hospital Concerns

- Clinics in red/orange area
- Will use JIC

- (info ODOT) shelter in place have a number with live person to explain what shelter in place is vs a recording. Set – up call center/ recording hot line Public Health/schools

Industry

- Remain open
- Staff home – Can't control – account for employees
 - Where and when left – (prefab waiver)
- 20 PPM – protect facility occupants if others trying to leave
- Capacity to stay overnight
 - Little – some survival supplies/cafeterias

Public/Private has to provide

- Expertise – how bad is this stuff?
- Hazmat – what info from industry – use as a gage
 - Monitoring equipment
- Industry equipment (what do you have)
 - People with knowledge....experience with tools – equipment
 - Monitoring equipment
- How do we reach each other?
 - 9-1-1 - responsible party “RP”
 - Master contact list
- Oregon State University
 - We have human resources
 - We have facilities
- CERT

Important info you take home

- 511 ODOT available
- Shelter in place in our own agencies
- Sharing of contact information – master list
- Info flash – notification system
- Pre determined detour routes – alternate traffic flow
- Work on ERP's – shelter in place
- Sign off employees who leave on own
- Second phase of communications at end of event
- Importance of capturing lessons learned at end of event
- Recognition of other community partners in response not just fire/police
