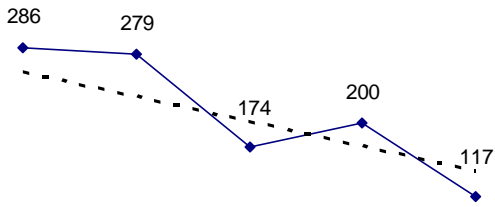
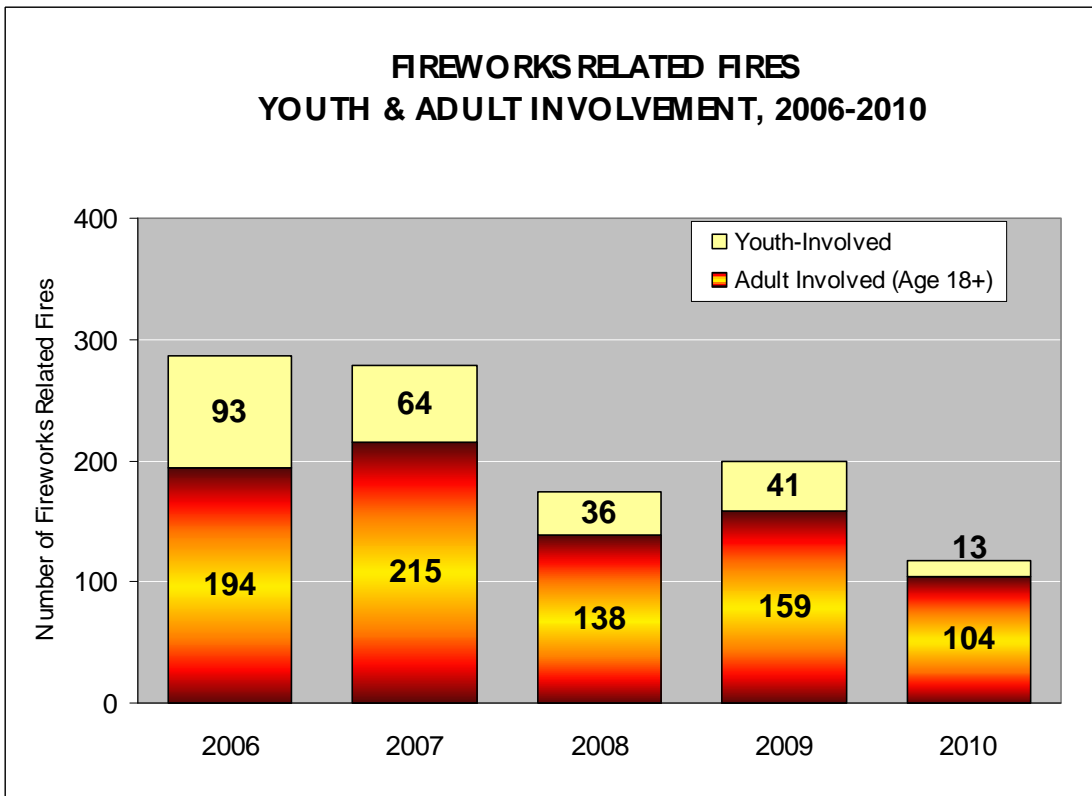


Fireworks Fires
5-Year Trend: -14.8%



Fireworks fires also continued a significant downward trend in 2010. Fireworks are responsible for 117 fires, 26 injuries, and an estimated \$1.7 million property damage in 2010. In spite of the decline in number of fires, the total property damage caused by fireworks is higher in 2010 than it has been in ten years.
