CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Pamela J. Hough, OT/R., is a licensee of the
Occupational Therapy Licensing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted an investigation and is prepared
to issue a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action to the licensee alleging (1)
that the licensee did not practice competently within the meaning of ORS
675.300(1)(d) when she applied cervical mechanical traction to client K.T.,
because cervical mechanical traction is not within the scope of practice of
occupational therapy and (2) that the licensee inappropriately used an aide to
assist in the provision of occupational therapy to client K.T., in violation of
OAR 339-010-0020(2)(f) and OAR 339-010-0055; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the licensee are desirous of resolving this
matter without further proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the licensee, being aware of her rights, hereby waives
her right to further notice of the allegations, waives her right to a hearing and

waives her right to judicial review and agrees to the entry of this Consent

Order:

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the licensee is
reprimanded.
