WHEREAS, Pamela W. Mist has applied to the Occupational Therapy Licensing Board for licensure as an occupational therapy assistant; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is a licensee of the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1998 the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice issued a Consent Order in Case No. 97-015 in which it disciplined the applicant for violation of the laws and rules applicable to Occupational Therapy Practice in the Maryland; and

WHEREAS, disciplinary action by the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice is grounds for denial of the applicant's application for licensure pursuant to ORS 675.300(1)(a) and OAR 339-010-0020(5)(e), which the Board could set forth in a Notice of Proposed Denial of Application For Licensure; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the applicant are desirous of resolving this matter without further proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, being aware of her rights, hereby waives her right to further notice of the allegations supporting the denial of her application, waives her right to a hearing and waives her right to judicial review and agrees to the entry of this Consent Order:

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application of Pamela M. Mist for licensure as an occupational therapy assistant is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. During the licensee's first six months of practice the licensee must work under the "close supervision" of her supervising occupational therapist, as that term is defined in OAR 339-010-0005(a).

2. At the end of the licensee's second, fourth and sixth month of practice the licensee shall cause her supervising occupational therapist to provide the Board with a written report regarding the licensee's performance as an occupational therapy assistant.

3. The applicant shall comply with all laws and rules applicable to occupational therapy practice.

4. Violation of any of the provisions of this Consent Order may result, after notice and hearing, in the Board imposing disciplinary action, including license revocation.
