WHEREAS, Applicant, has not practiced for over two years and has applied for licensure as an Occupational Therapy Assistant in Oregon;

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted an investigation of Licensee and determined it has grounds to take disciplinary action;

WHEREAS, the Board and the applicant are desirous of resolving this matter without further proceedings; and to determine stipulated probationary conditions under which applicant can practice occupational therapy in Oregon; and

WHEREAS this Consent Order between the parties is the final resolution of the Board's investigation. The applicant, being aware of his rights, hereby waives the right to further notice, waives the right to any hearing and waives the right to judicial review or further appeal and agrees to the entry of this: CONSENT ORDER FOR PROBATIONARY LICENSE WITH CONDITIONS based on the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure as an Occupational Therapy Assistant received by the Oregon Board on April 6, 2010;

2. Applicant has not worked for a period over two years since his license in the state of Arizona;
3. In response to question 14 of his application for licensure, Applicant responded “Yes” and reported an arrest and conviction for driving under the influence of intoxicants in Arizona in 2005 and an arrest and conviction for disorderly conduct in Arizona in 2006.

WHEREAS the Board has agreed with the applicant on the conditions under which the applicant Patrick Parton can practice occupational therapy in Oregon, under a probationary license with conditions.

WHEREAS under ORS 675.320 the Board enforces provisions to generally supervise the practice of occupational therapy; and under ORS 675.300 the Board may impose probationary conditions.

WHEREAS at the July 17, 2009 meeting the Board considered what probationary conditions to include in the CONSENT ORDER FOR PROBATIONARY LICENSE WITH CONDITIONS to assure that the Board protects the public.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That the applicant be issued a probationary license;
2. The applicant shall work as an Occupational Therapy Assistant under “close supervision” as defined in OAR 339-010-0005, and which “requires daily, direct contact in person at the work site”.
3. The applicant will have a six month review by his supervisor sent to the Board.

4. If the applicant has successfully completed the probationary conditions listed above, and the Board is satisfied with the six month review, a regular renewal license may be issued in May, 2010.
