CONSENT ORDER FOR
2 YEAR SUSPENSION

TO: SCOTT KEMP, OT

THIS MATTER comes before the Oregon Occupational Therapy Licensing Board (Board) which is the state agency responsible for licensing, disciplining and regulating the practice of Occupation Therapy in the State of Oregon. The Board issued an emergency suspension order on August 20, 2009, suspending SCOTT KEMP's (Licensee) occupational therapy license and find grounds for further disciplinary action. This Consent Order is the final resolution of these proceedings, including the right to hearing, appeal or judicial review.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Board and Licensee agree to resolve these matters informally on the following terms:

1. The parties stipulate that in July 2009, licensee, at the time, a co-owner/manager of Apex In-Home Care Agency stole prescription medication, Xanax, from an elderly client of the agency. He subsequently consumed all 90, one-milligram pills, during the course of a week, thereby significantly altering his ability to function. After taking a couple of these pills, he was not able to recall taking more or any of his actions while on the medication.

2. The parties further stipulate that the above-described conduct constitutes a violation of OAR-339-010-0020(1)(g) and OAR 339-010-0020(4) which are grounds for discipline pursuant to ORS 675.300(1)(a).

CONSENT ORDER FOR TWO YEAR SUSPENSION (SCOTT KEMP)

3. Licensee agrees that the Board may enter this order set forth below.

4. Licensee, being aware of his rights, hereby waives the right to further notice, waives the right to any hearing and waives the right to judicial review or further appeal of this matter.

5. Violation of this Consent Order or any statute or rule governing the practice of occupational therapy shall be grounds for license revocation or denial of reinstatement.

6. This Consent Order shall take effect on the date it is signed by the Board.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Licensee's license to practice as an Occupational Therapist is SUSPENDED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS from the effective date of this order. During the suspension period, Licensee must:

- Obtain urine testing for controlled substances and submit the results of such tests to the Board;
- Continue to attend Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) meetings on a regular basis. Licensee authorizes his AA sponsor to notify the Board during the suspension period about his monthly attendance; and
- Continue with an addiction treatment program and provide monthly reports on his progress to the Board. Licensee further agrees to obtain a comprehensive yearly report on his attendance, progress, sobriety and prognosis, and need for further treatment from the program and submit it to the Board.

FURTHER, Licensee may not apply to renew his license within the two year suspension period. Licensee may re-apply in two years from the effective date of this order for reinstatement of license, and the Board will consider the application. However, in
