


Oregon Explorer Map Viewer
Guidance for Obtaining the 10-digit Hydrologic Unit Code (HUC)



1. Go to <http://oregonexplorer.info/> and click on 'Oregon Explorer Map Viewer' to open the tool.



2. Switch the Map Theme to 'Watershed Restoration'




3. Enter the town closest in proximity to your project in the search box (e.g., Salem).
 - a. Results will be listed in the left hand menu.
 - b. Click on 'Table View'
 - c. Select the 'Place Names' tab
 - d. Click on the name of the town once and the map will zoom to the location.

Note: the search box is in the upper right hand corner of the map viewer.



4. Switch the menu on the left to see the map layers.
 - a. On the 'Explore Map' tab select 'Display for...'. In the drop down menu click on 'Select None'
 - b. Scroll down the menu toward the end and check only 'Hydrologic Boundaries: 5th level (HUC10)'



5. Select the 'Point Identify' tool and click once on the center of the map.

Note: the 'HUC_10' number that is displayed is the 10-digit hydrologic unit code required for the grant application.
