About the OYA Mental Health Gap

The Oregon Youth Authority has conducted the Mental Health Gap Survey every other year since 2000. Data are collected on all youth in OYA custody on April 1 of the survey year.

The survey allows the agency to make a comprehensive assessment of the mental health and other treatment services needed by youth in OYA custody. Survey results are analyzed to identify youth service gaps and to advocate for funding for important services during the budget process.

Typically, Juvenile Parole and Probation Officers complete the survey for OYA youth in the community, and treatment managers complete the survey for youth in OYA correctional facilities. Information for the survey is derived from youth assessments such as mental health, substance use, and other evaluations in the youth's case file.

There are only a few changes from year to year in the survey, which makes it possible to look for trends in the results for many of the survey questions.

Highlights from the 2010 Survey

2010 Snapshot

While many youth in OYA custody have troubled mental health and substance use histories, one pattern that emerged from the data was the high proportion of females in OYA close custody who were reported to have these issues. This population was frequently the most negatively affected group compared to OYA-supervised males in close custody, females in the community, and males in the community. There is ample evidence that youth coming from dysfunctional homes are more likely to engage in criminal behaviors, and findings from the mental health gap survey corroborate this point. Survey questions relating to a youth's biological parents showed that many OYA youth may have had exposure to significant mental health and substance abuse issues in their home environments. Furthermore, one in eight youth under OYA supervision already had a child of his or her own. This underscores the importance of effective interventions and services that enable OYA youth to address these issues.

Trends

OYA appears to be managing an increasingly large population of youth with lower IQs, specifically IQ scores less than 80. Furthermore, the trend seems to hold true for youth in OYA facilities as well as OYA-supervised youth in the community. See question **1.10 IQ – INTELLIGENCE QUOTIENT** in the tables *Summary Trends by Sex (2004 – 2010)*.

Results from question **2.3 PERCENTAGE OF YOUTH WHOSE DRUG OR DRUGS OF CHOICE INCLUDE...** show a decline in methamphetamine as a drug of choice (16% in 2008, 10% in 2010). This was a new question on the 2008 survey, so a trend cannot be presumed. Nonetheless, the difference seems substantial, and the results for both OYA facility youth and community-supervised youth were similar to the OYA aggregate. 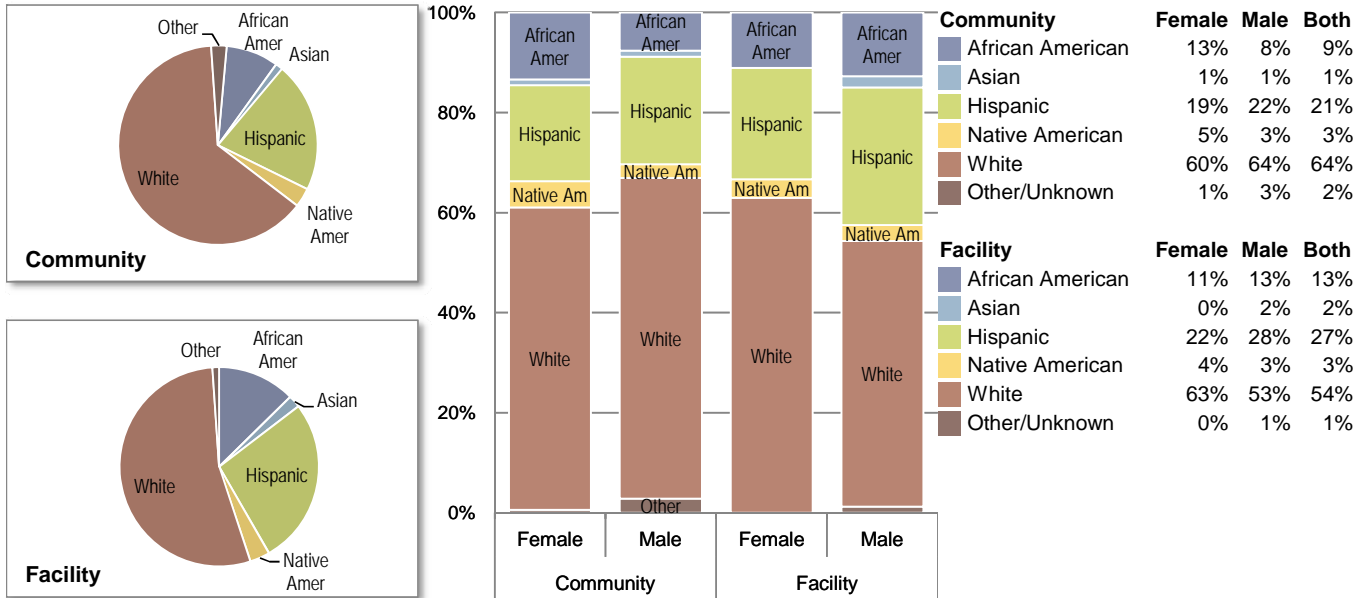

DEMOGRAPHICS

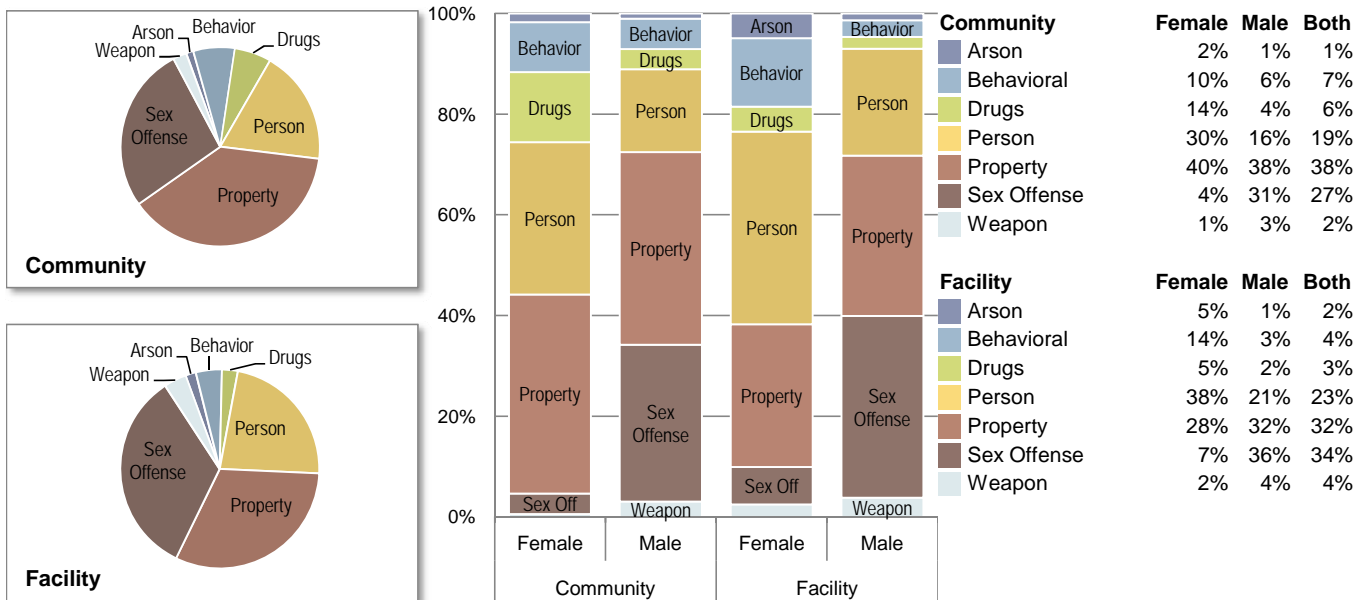
Race/Ethnicity

The majority of youth in OYA custody were White; however, minorities were actually over-represented in OYA's facility and community populations. For comparison, in 2008, the race/ethnicity breakout of Oregon's population age 10-17 was African American (3%), Asian (4%), White (75%), Hispanic (16%), and Native American (2%).



Crime Type

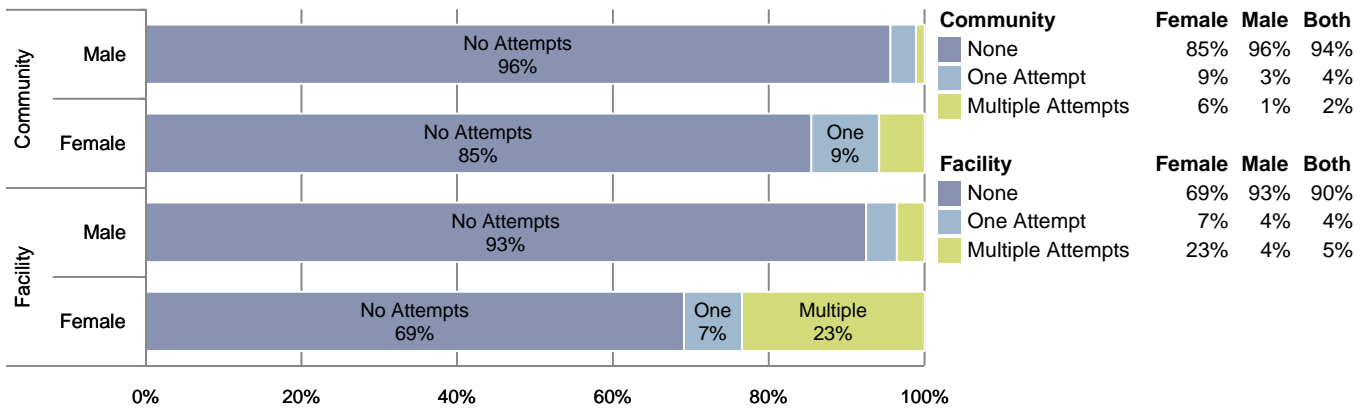
By crime type, there were more property offenders under OYA community supervision than any other crime type. In OYA facilities, the most prevalent crime types differ for males and females. Most males in close custody were committed for sex offenses, while females were committed for other types of person crimes.

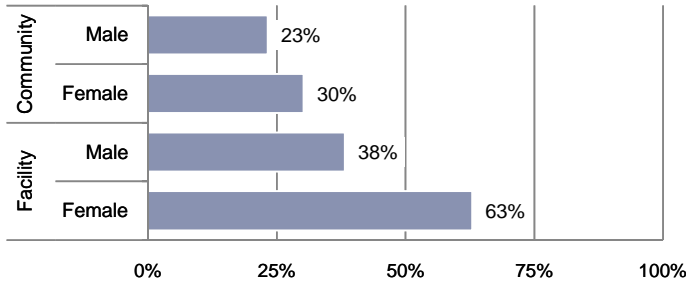
Suicide Attempt History in Past 3 Years (1.1)

In both the OYA close custody and community populations, females were more likely to have a history of attempted suicide than males. Thirty percent of females in close custody had attempted suicide in the past three years (one attempt 7%, multiple attempts 23%) compared with 15% of females under community supervision (one attempt 9%, multiple attempts 6%).



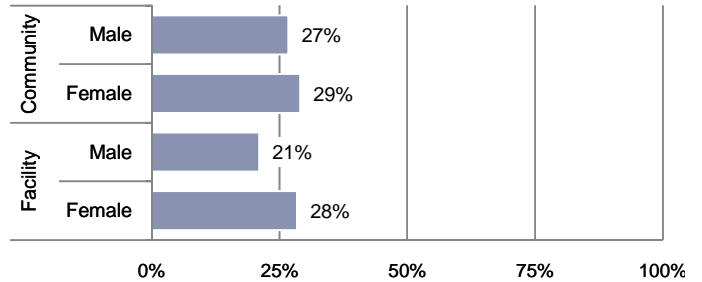
Currently Taking Psychotropic Medications (1.2)

In close custody, the majority of females were taking psychotropic medications.



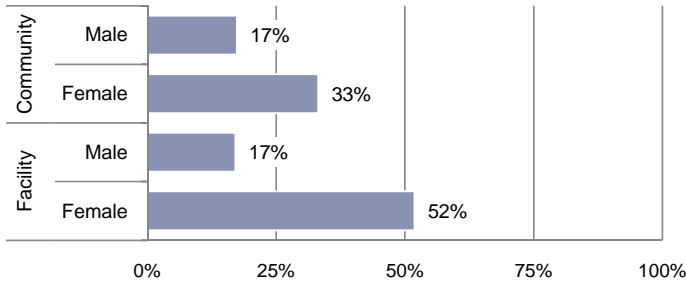
Biological Parents have a Psychiatric History (1.4)

Approximately one in four youth under OYA supervision had parents with a psychiatric history.



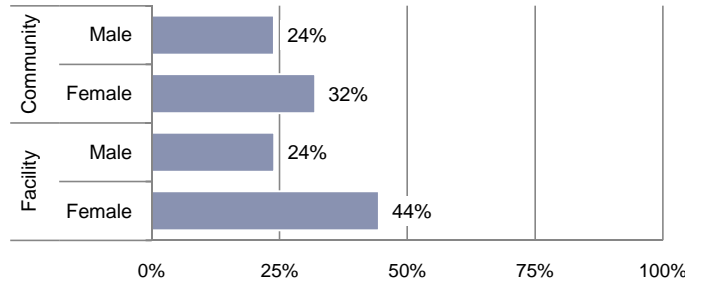
Documented History of Sexual Abuse (1.6.1)

OYA females were more likely to have a history of sexual abuse than males. In close custody, over half of the females had been sexually abused.



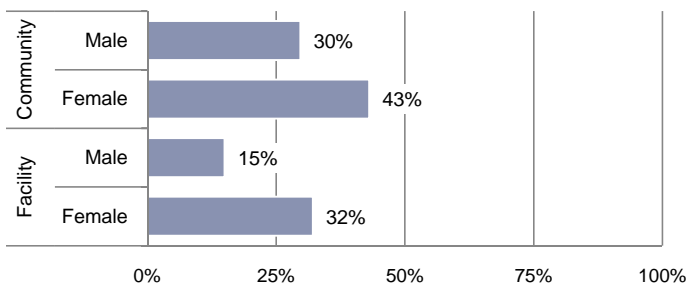
Documented History of Physical Abuse (1.6.2)

Females were more likely to have a history of physical abuse than males. Approximately one in four males under OYA supervision had a history of physical abuse.



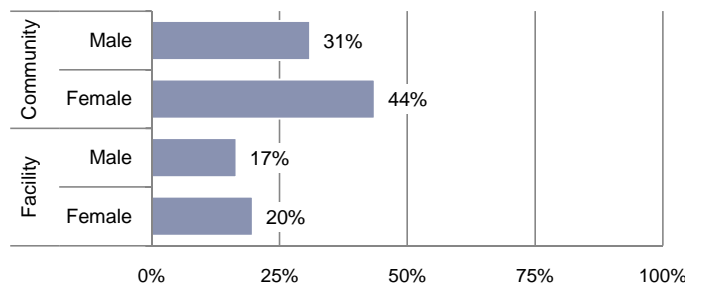
Documented History of Emotional Abuse (1.6.3)

Documented History of Neglect (1.6.4)

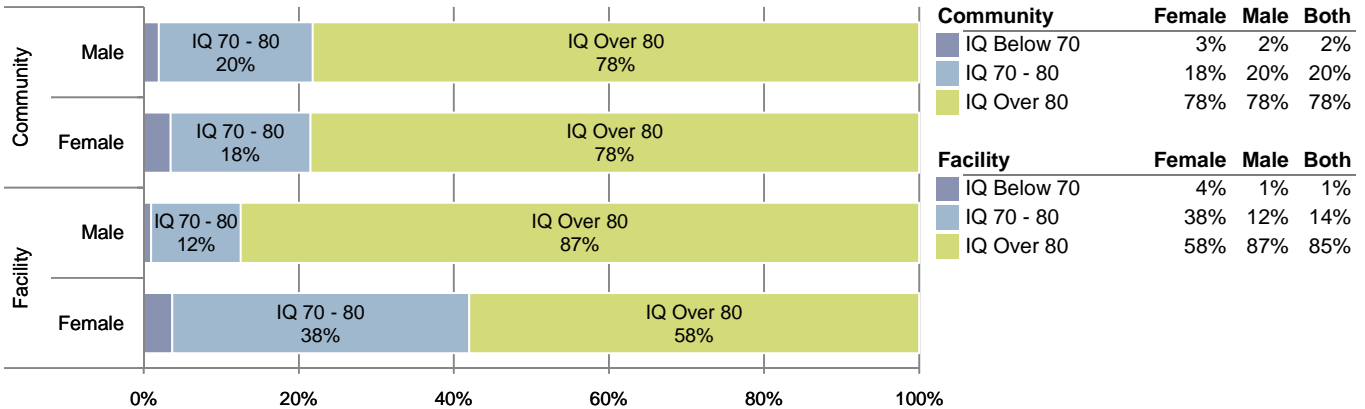
Females under OYA community supervision were the most likely to have a documented history of neglect.

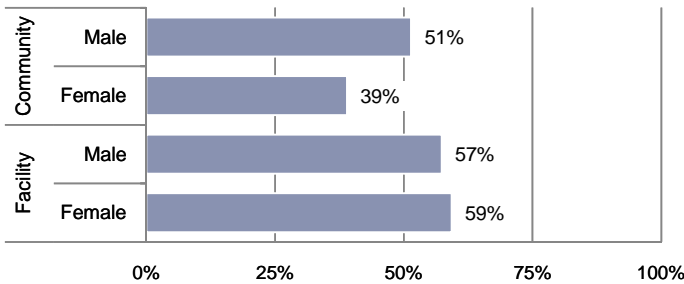
IQ - Intelligence Quotient (1.10)

Forty-two percent of females under OYA close custody supervision had IQs in the lower two categories : IQ Below 70 (4%) and IQ 70-80 (38%). Over 20% of OYA youth supervised in the community had an IQ below 80.



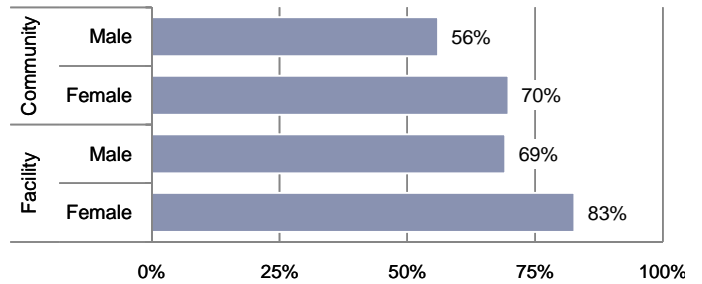
Diagnosed with a Conduct Disorder (1.11)

With the exception of females under community supervision, the majority of youth had been diagnosed with a conduct disorder.



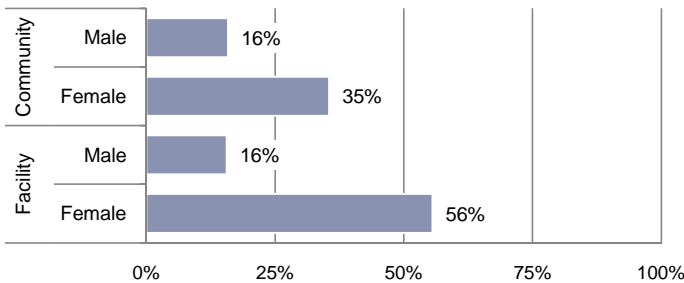
Axis 1 Diagnosis, Excluding Conduct Disorder (1.12)

The majority of OYA youth had an Axis 1 diagnosis. Over 80% of females in close custody had an axis 1 diagnosis.



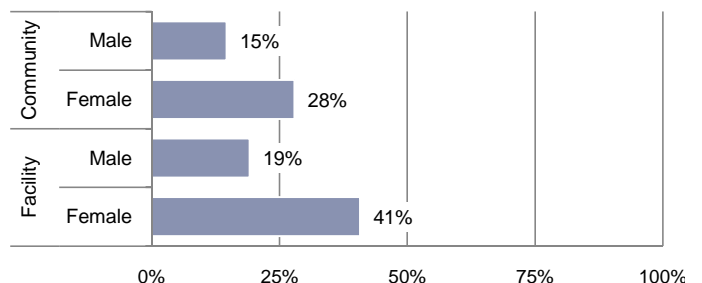
Axis 1 Type: Anxiety/Trauma (1.13)

Fifty-six percent of females in close custody had been diagnosed with an axis 1 disorder such as post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), anxiety, or obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD).



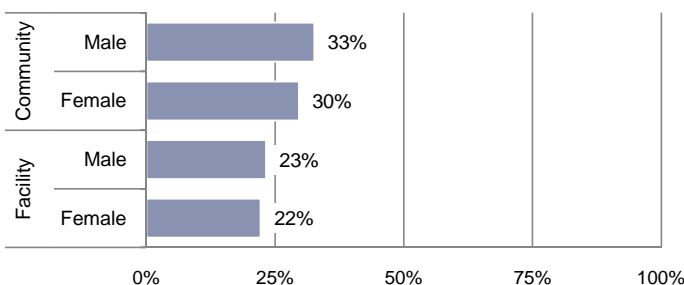
Axis 1 Type: Mood Disorder (1.13)

Females were more likely than males to have been diagnosed with a mood disorder such as major depression, dysthymia, or bipolar.



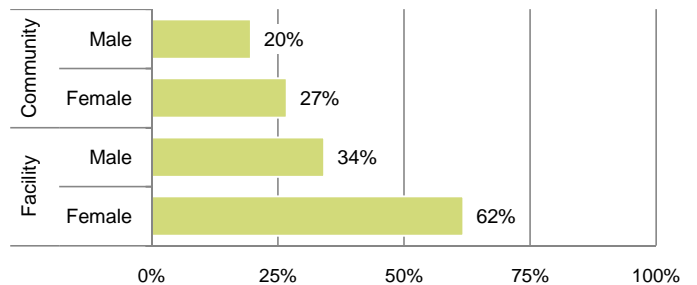
Axis 1 Type: Behavior Disorder of Childhood Onset (1.13)

Youth supervised in the community had the highest rates of behavior disorders of childhood onset, such as oppositional defiant disorder (ODD) and attention deficit disorder (ADD).



Axis 1 (1.12) and Currently Taking Psychotropics (1.2)

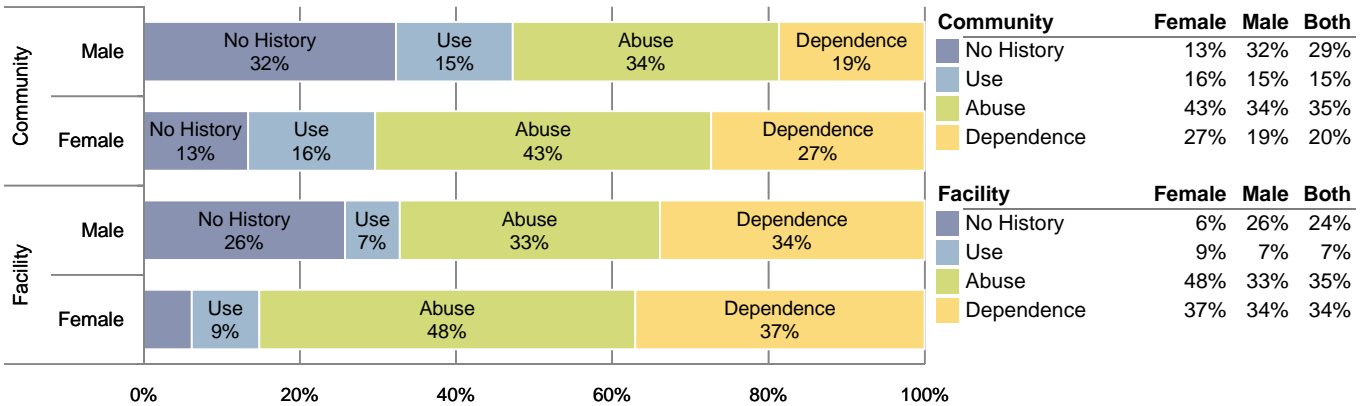
Over 60% of females in OYA close custody were diagnosed with an axis 1 disorder (excluding conduct disorder) and were also taking psychotropic medications.



2.0 SUBSTANCE USE

Level of Drug and/or Alcohol Use (2.2)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision had a history of substance use, and females were more likely to have a history than males. In fact, 85% of females in close custody had a serious substance history—drug or alcohol abuse/dependence.

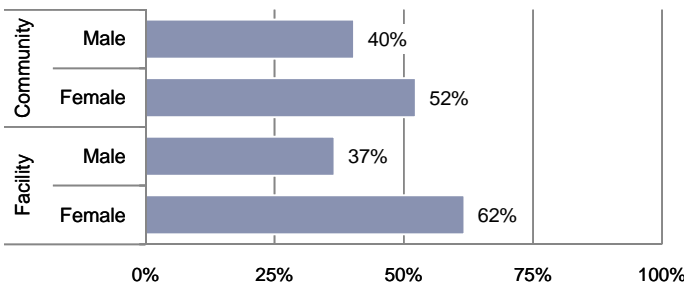


Drugs of Choice

The four most common drugs of choice were alcohol, cocaine, methamphetamine, and marijuana. More than one choice was allowed.

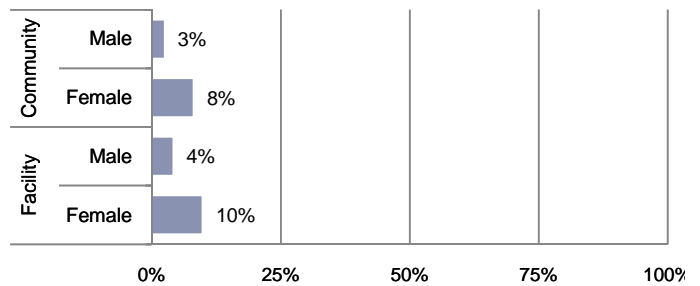
Alcohol (2.3.1)

Alcohol was the second most popular drug of choice.



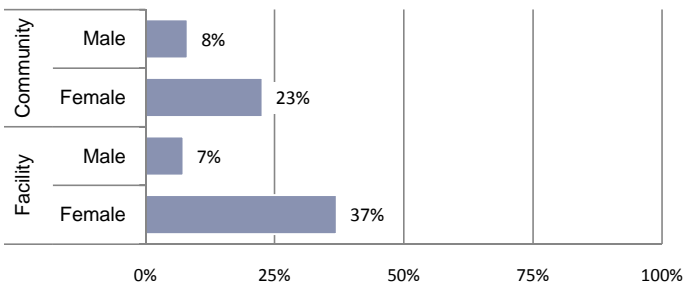
Cocaine (2.3.3)

Females were more likely to include cocaine as a drug of choice.



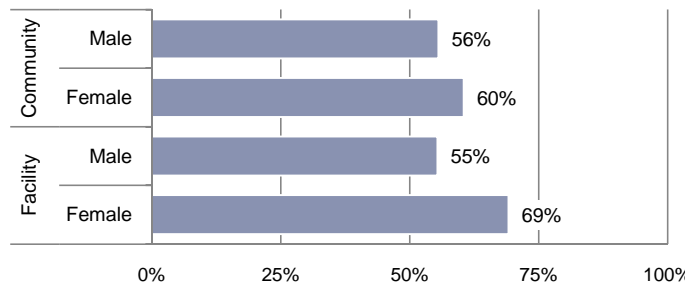
Methamphetamine (2.3.8)

Females were more likely to include methamphetamine as a drug of choice than males. Methamphetamine was a drug of choice for 37% percent of females in close custody.



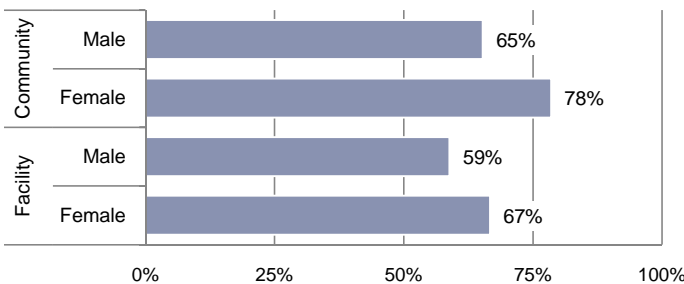
Marijuana (2.3.9)

Marijuana was the most popular drug of choice. The majority of OYA-supervised youth have used marijuana.



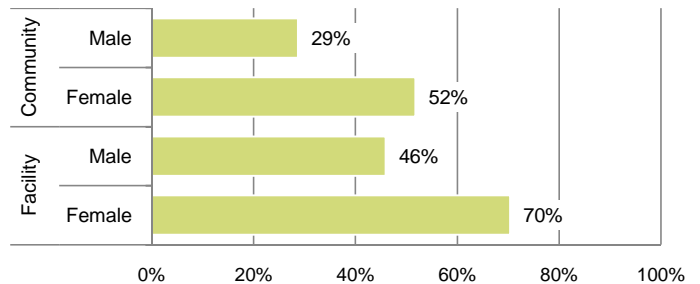
Parents have History of Substance Abuse (2.5)

The majority of OYA-supervised youth had biological parents with a documented history of drug and/or alcohol abuse.



Axis 1 (1.12) and Substance Abuse/Dependence (2.2)

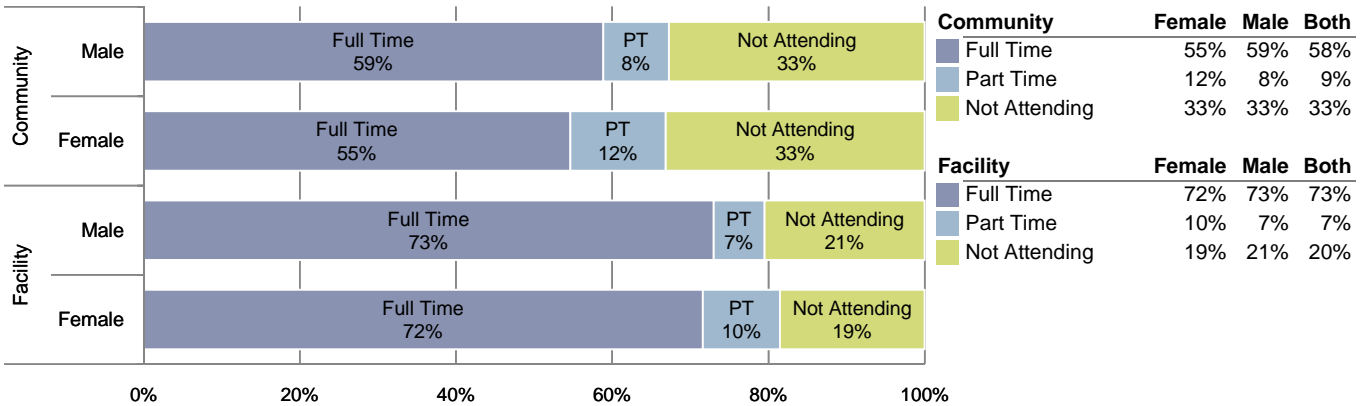
The majority of OYA-supervised females had a co-occurring disorder: axis 1 and a serious drug or alcohol problem.

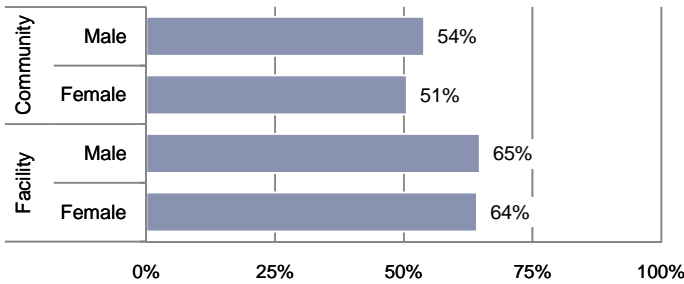
School Attendance Status (3.1)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision were attending school full time. The rates of school attendance were somewhat higher in the facility than in the community population.



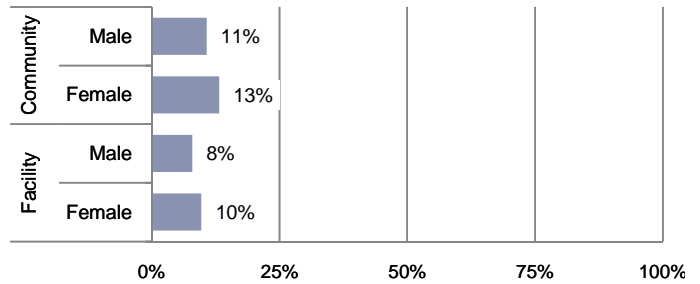
Working to Achieve a High School Diploma (3.2.1)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision were working toward their high school diploma.



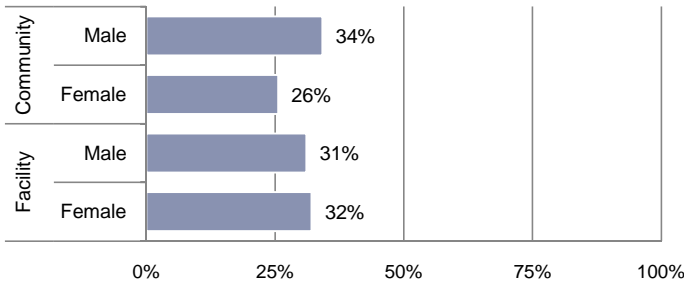
Working to Achieve a GED (3.2.2)

The share of youth working toward their GED was higher among those supervised in the community than those in close custody.



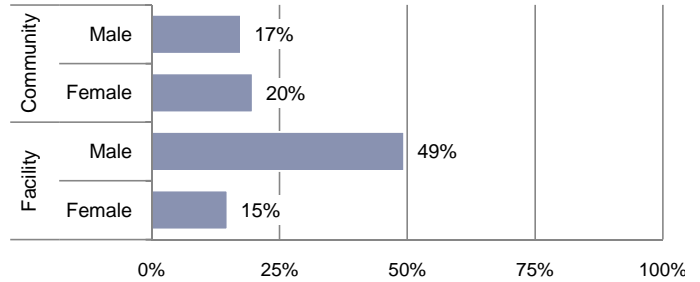
Had in Individualized Education Program (3.4)

Approximately one in three OYA-supervised youth had an individualized education program (IEP), a plan for educational services developed for students in special education programs.



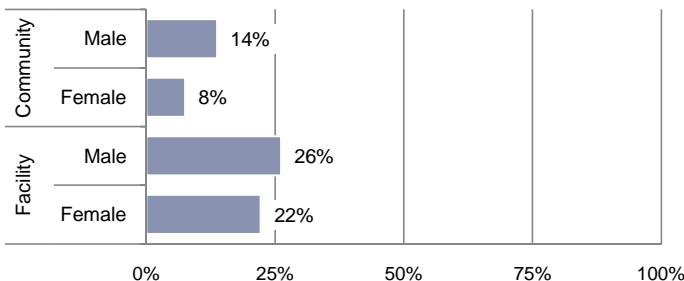
Engaged in Vocational Training (3.5)

Nearly half of the males in OYA close custody were engaged in vocational training.



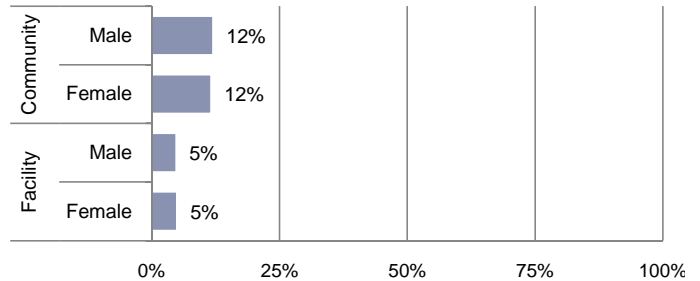
Completed High School Diploma (3.7.1)

Completed GED (3.7.2)

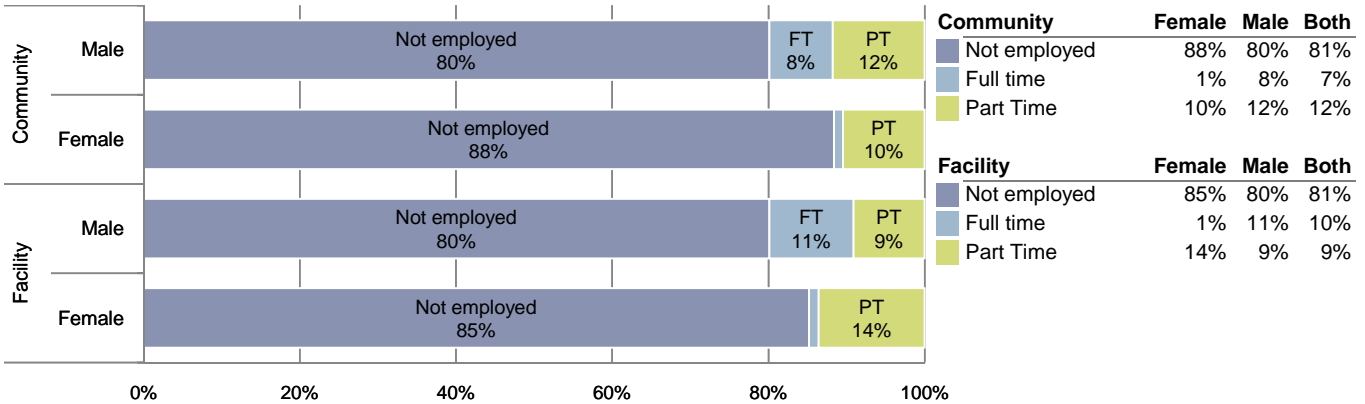
Completing a GED was more common among community-supervised youth than youth in close custody.

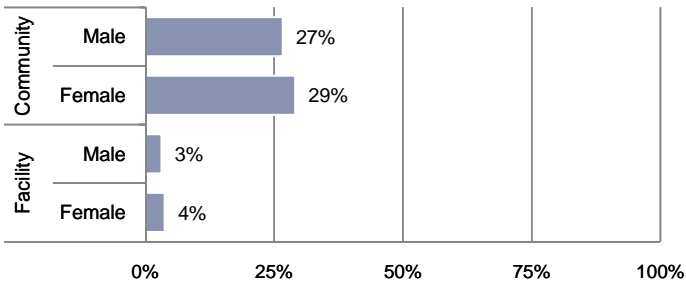
Employment Status (3.10)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision were not employed. Males were more likely to be employed than females both in the community and in close custody.



Seeking Employment (3.11)

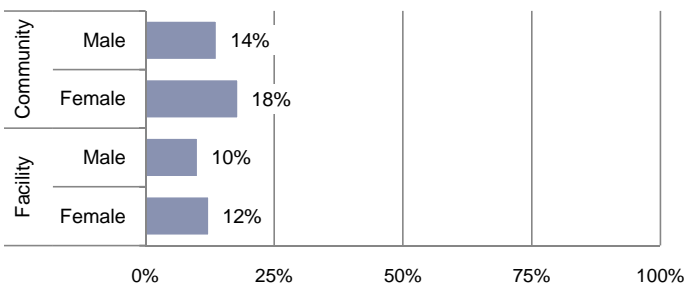
Youth under OYA community supervision were more likely to be seeking employment than youth in close custody.

Females were somewhat more likely to be documented as the biological parent of a child than males in OYA's community and facility populations.
