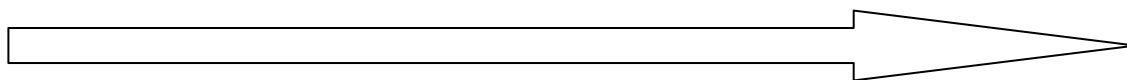

***ERASOR:** The Estimate of Risk of Adolescent Sexual Offense Recidivism (ERASOR) is an empirically-guided checklist designed to assist evaluators to estimate the short-term risk of a sexual reoffense for youth aged 12 up to and including 18 years. The ERASOR provides objective coding instructions for 25 risk factors (16 dynamic and 9 static). The OYA continues to assess offenders beyond 18 years of age with the ERASOR for historical tracking.
