

## **Certified Water Right Examiner Study Guide and Information for Examination**

The Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE) test is given annually. Applicants will have four hours to complete the exam. The exam consists of multiple choice and true / false questions, questions requiring the performance of calculations, and questions requiring the applicant to select items from lists.
