Individuals served by Oregon's Workforce System can, and often do, receive services by more than one agency. The longer the time period of reporting, the greater the chance an individual is served multiple times. Quarterly PRISM reports display duplicated numbers. This report shows the actual placement rate as reported on PRISM quarterly reports and the unduplicated placement rate when an individual is counted only once for placement.

Placement Rate - The total number of participants who were employed the quarter of exit or the first quarter after exit divided by the total number of participants who exited during during the reporting period.
