This matter came before the Board on July 26, 2001 for consideration of the Proposed Order issued on May 25, 2001. The licensee appeared personally and without counsel and presented argument to the Board. Following deliberation, the Board issues the following Order.

**ORDER**

1. The Board adopts the findings of fact and the conclusions of law in the proposed order. The Board makes the further finding of fact that the licensee does not present a risk to the public health, safety or welfare. The proposed order contained no finding on this matter.

2. Despite the licensee's conviction, based on the evidence received by the Board during its hearing (which included a transcript of the testimony given at the licensee's criminal trial), the Board is of the opinion that the licensee did not engage in the conduct for which he was convicted and he did not engage in any other inappropriate behavior regarding the patient.

3. The Interim Consent Order issued on October 16, 2000 suspending the licensee's license pending the outcome of this proceeding is vacated.

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4. The license of Nicholas V. Borodko to practice physical therapy is fully reinstated without condition and this matter is now closed.

NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

If you wish to appeal the final order you must first file with the Board a petition for rehearing or for reconsideration. When the Board issues an order in response to your petition for rehearing or for reconsideration you must file a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the Board's order is served on you. If the Board fails to issue an order in response to your petition for rehearing or for reconsideration within 60 days from the date you filed your petition, your petition is deemed denied. You must then file a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within one hundred twenty days from the date you filed your petition for rehearing or for reconsideration with the Board. See ORS 183.480 *et seq.*
