WHEREAS, Victoria M. Vestal, PT "licensee" is a licensee of the Physical Therapist Licensing Board "Board"; and

WHEREAS, Victoria M. Vestal, PT is the owner of Pacific Crest Physical Therapy in Warrenton, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Board received a complaint alleging failure to provide required training and improper utilization of physical therapist aides at Pacific Crest Physical Therapy in Warrenton, Oregon;

WHEREAS, the Board conducted an investigation and is prepared to issue a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action based on the fact that the licensee failed to properly train, document and utilize physical therapist aides at her clinic, Pacific Crest Physical Therapy, in Warrenton, Oregon, which is in violation of Oregon Administrative Rules 848-020-0000 through 848-020-0060; and

WHEREAS, the licensee and the Board are desirous of settling and resolving these matters by way of this Consent Order and without further proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the licensee is aware of her right to a hearing on these matters with the assistance of counsel and is aware of her right to judicial review of any adverse decision by the Board and she hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives those rights and agrees to the entry of this Consent Order:

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NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The licensee shall be placed on probation upon signing of this Consent Order until items 2 and 3, below, have been satisfactorily completed.

2. The licensee shall provide the Board with a revised policies and procedures manual as it pertains to the proper training, documentation and utilization of physical therapist aides. Such manual shall be delivered to the Board within 30 days from the signing of this Consent Order.

3. In compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule 848-020-0040, the licensee shall provide, retroactively, 40 hours of on-the-job training for all physical therapist aides and provide evidence, to the Board, to show how this has been accomplished.
