WHEREAS, Karl Kolbeck (licensee) is licensed by the Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) as a physical therapist having been issued License No. 2675; and

WHEREAS, the Board received a complaint, conducted an investigation and is prepared to initiate disciplinary action alleging that the licensee violated patient confidentiality, in violation of OAR 848-010-0050(1)(f) and OAR 848-010-0050(2)(a) and ORS 688.140(2)(d); and

WHEREAS, the Board and the licensee are desirous of resolving these matters without further proceedings and by way of this Consent Order; and

WHEREAS, the licensee is aware of his right to a formal notice, to a hearing at which he may be represented by counsel, to cross-examine witnesses and present evidence in his own behalf and the right to appeal any adverse decision to the Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, by signing this Consent Order, the licensee waives confidentiality and authorizes Dr. Mussack to release to the Board any summaries or reports resulting from this Consent Order as the Board may request; and

WHEREAS, the licensee voluntarily waives these rights:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The licensee is reprimanded.

2. For two years from the date of this Consent Order, the licensee shall have a mental health check-up at his own expense every six months with Steven E. Mussack, Ph.D. for the purpose of monitoring the licensee's ongoing emotional stability and he shall cause Dr. Mussack to provide to the Board summaries regarding the licensee's stabilization and his treatment needs, if any.

3. Violation of the provisions of this Consent Order may, after notice and hearing, result in further disciplinary action by the Board, as authorized by law. This may include license revocation.
