Licensee.	)	STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining physical therapists and physical therapist assistants pursuant to ORS 688.140 and 688.160. Suzanne Trebnick, PT (Licensee) is licensed by the Board to practice as a physical therapist in Oregon. The Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Civil Penalty) on August 18, 2005. In lieu of proceeding to hearing, the Board and Licensee agree to resolve this case as follows:

1. Licensee stipulates that while owning and practicing physical therapy at Laurelhurst Physical Therapy Clinic (Laurelhurst), she allowed physical therapist aides to initiate or administer procedures or modalities the first time those procedures or modalities were administered to a patient, which is in violation of OAR 848-020-0060(9) (2005).

2. Licensee stipulates that while owning and practicing physical therapy at Laurelhurst, she acted contrary to Medicare regulations by allowing physical therapist aides (aides) to provide physical therapy treatments and subsequently mistakenly allowed Medicare to be billed for those services provided by the aides. Licensee, as an owner of Laurelhurst, initially received compensation for the services provided by the aides, but refunded the money to Medicare when the Board investigated this case and the Licensee realized the billing was in error. Licensee's actions constitute a violation of ORS 688.140(2) (2003), which is grounds for discipline.

3. Licensee stipulates that while owning and practicing physical therapy at Laurelhurst, she acted contrary to Medicare regulations by allowing student physical therapists (students) to provide physical therapy treatments and subsequently mistakenly allowed Medicare to be billed for those services provided by the students. Licensee, as an owner of Laurelhurst, received

1 compensation for the services provided by the students, but refunded the money to Medicare when  
2 the Board investigated this case and the Licensee realized the billing was in error. Licensee's  
3 actions constitute a violation of ORS 688.140(2) (2003), which is grounds for discipline.

4 4. Licensee stipulates that she failed to properly document her medical records by not  
5 documenting treatment goals that were objectively measurable and not including all of the  
6 requirements in her daily records of treatment. Licensee's failure to properly document the records  
7 constitutes violations of OAR 848-040-0140(1)(a) and 848-040-0150(1)(c) and(d) (2005).

8 5. Licensee stipulates to the following sanction:

9 a. The Board imposes a \$5,000.00 civil penalty, which is payable within 30 days of  
10 the date this Stipulated Agreement and Final Order is signed by the Board; and

11 b. Licensee will be on probation for two years with the following conditions:

12 1. Complete, within 6 months of the date this agreement is signed by the Board,  
13 Board approved courses on: A) Federal regulations governing compliance for the  
14 provision of physical therapy services under Medicare; and B) Physical therapy  
15 documentation.

16 2. Agree to Board on-site audits of medical and billing records during the  
17 probationary period.
