STIPULATION AND FINAL ORDER

The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining physical therapists and physical therapist assistants pursuant to ORS 688.140 and 688.160. Stanley Gorman, PT (Licensee) is licensed by the Board to practice as a physical therapist in Oregon. The Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Civil Penalty) on November 20, 2006. In lieu of proceeding to hearing, the Board and Licensee agree to resolve this case as follows:

1. Licensee stipulates that he committed the following acts which are violations and subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to ORS 688.140(2)(a):

a. During 2000 through 2006, the record of training for aides employed at Gateway failed to include the aide's signature and when the aide training was conducted by someone other than the licensee, the records failed to include the signature of the person who actually trained the aides in violation of OAR 848-020-0040(2)(c)(E)(2003) & (2005).

b. Licensee utilized his initials, rather than his full signature, when authenticating record entries in violation of OAR 848-040-0110(5)(January 2005).

c. During times when Licensee was the supervising physical therapist, Licensee allowed aides to independently make subjective entries in patient records in violation of OAR 848-020-0060(10) (January 2005).

2. Based on the above-referenced facts and violations and based on the fact that Licensee was previously disciplined in the year 2003 for multiple record keeping violations (resolved with a Consent Order), Licensee stipulates to the Board imposing the following sanction:
