The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining physical therapists and physical therapist assistants pursuant to ORS 688.160. Randall W. Ojua (Applicant) is an applicant for licensure as a physical therapist assistant. On May 18, 2005, the Board issued a temporary permit allowing the Applicant to practice as a physical therapist assistant (PTA). Subsequently, on July 14, 2005, the Board issued an Emergency Suspension Order, which suspended Applicant's right to practice as a PTA.

STIPULATIONS

1. Applicant's license to practice massage in Oregon was voluntarily surrendered on August 11, 2003 after the Oregon Board of Massage Therapists issued an Amended Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action, which proposed to revoke his license for sexual misconduct.
2. The actions leading to the surrender of Applicant's license as a massage therapist are grounds for denial of his application for licensure as a physical therapist assistant pursuant to ORS 688.140(2)(d) and OAR 848-010-0044(7).
3. The Board and Applicant agree to resolve this matter through this Stipulation and Final Order.
4. The Board agrees to grant Applicant a PTA license, whereby Applicant will be on probation for five years.
5. Applicant is aware of his right to notice, to be represented by counsel, to a hearing where he could call witnesses and cross-examine witnesses called by the Board, and the Applicant hereby waives these rights and agrees to entry of this Stipulation and Final Order.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The application of Randall W. Ojua for a license as a physical therapist assistant is granted, and he is placed on probation for five years from the execution date of this Stipulation and Final Order.
2. Any violation of the statutes or administrative rules, after notice and hearing, may result in disciplinary action, up to and including revocation of the license.
