STIPULATED AGREEMENT
AND FINAL ORDER (REPRIMAND)

The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining physical therapists and physical therapist assistants pursuant to former ORS 688.160. Erik Zamboni, PT (Licensee) is licensed by the Board to practice as a physical therapist in Oregon. The Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Civil Penalty) on February 1, 2006. In lieu of proceeding to hearing, the Board and Licensee agree to resolve this case as follows:

1. Licensee stipulates that he failed to authenticate multiple entries in the patient record for patient T.S. by failing to sign them from August 27, 2004 through September 29, 2004, and that some of his daily records of treatment provided for one other patient did not meet documentation standards because the records did not include, at a minimum, specific treatments provided or assessment of patient's response to treatment, including changes in objective and measurable findings as they related to existing goals. Licensee's actions constitute a violation of OAR 848-040-0110(5) and OAR 848-040-0150(1)(b) and (d). The above referenced facts and violations are grounds for discipline pursuant to former ORS 688.140(2)(d) and OAR 848-045-0020(2)(h).
2. Licensee stipulates to the Board imposing the following sanction:
 - a. Licensee is hereby REPRIMANDED.
 - b. Licensee will attend and complete a Board approved course on documentation.

c. Licensee is assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$500, which is stayed pending completion of the documentation course. Upon submission of proof of completion and payment for the documentation course, the cost of the course will be credited against the civil penalty. The balance of the civil penalty will be due and payable within 10 days of the proof of completion; and

d. Licensee will be subject to a Board review of his patient records during the six months following the completion of the documentation course.
