WHEREAS, Greg C. Halvorson ("applicant") applied for licensure by endorsement as a physical therapist; and

WHEREAS, on his application dated February 18, 2000 the applicant answered, "No" in response to the question, "Have you ever been arrested, charged with, convicted of or sentenced for a legal offense other than a traffic ticket in any state, possession of the United States or foreign country?" contained on the application; and

WHEREAS, the applicant had been arrested in Portland, Oregon and Eugene, Oregon in 1985, he had been arrested and convicted in Seattle, Washington for possession of controlled substances and he was arrested in Portland, Oregon in 1989 for driving under the influence of intoxicants; and

WHEREAS, the Board is prepared to issue a Notice of Proposed Denial of Application for Licensure by Endorsement based upon his misrepresentation; and

WHEREAS, the applicant and the Board are desirous of resolving this matter without further proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the applicant knowingly and voluntarily waives his right to notice, to representation by counsel, to a hearing at which he could call witnesses and cross-examine witnesses called by the Board and to judicial review of any adverse Board decision; and

WHEREAS, the applicant agrees to the entry of this Consent Order:

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The application of Greg C. Halvorson ("licensee") for a license to practice physical therapy is granted.

2. The licensee is placed on probation for a period of five (5) years under the following conditions:

A. The licensee shall provide a copy of this Consent Order to every potential physical therapy employer prior to accepting employment.

B. The licensee shall notify the Board in writing of the name and address of every physical therapy employer within ten days of accepting employment.

C. The licensee shall cause his physical therapy employer to provide the Board with written performance appraisals every six months.

D. The licensee shall obey all laws and rules applicable to physical therapy practice.

E. The licensee shall not engage in any conduct involving dishonesty.

3. Violation of the provisions of this Consent Order may, after notice and hearing, result in further disciplinary action by the Board including license revocation.

4. This Consent Order shall become effective upon signature by the Board.
