The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining physical therapists and physical therapist assistants pursuant to ORS 688.140 and ORS 688.160. Susan Priestman (Applicant) is an applicant for licensure as a physical therapist. The Board and Applicant agree to resolve this matter through this Stipulated Agreement and Final Order.

STIPULATIONS

1. Applicant failed to disclose on her application for a physical therapy license, that she had been the subject of disciplinary action by the Board of Physical Therapy Examiners in the State of Nevada once in 2002 and once in 2006. The non-disclosure of her disciplinary action by another state licensing agency is grounds for denial of her application for licensure as a physical therapist pursuant to ORS 688.120, ORS 688.140(1)(a), ORS 688.140(2)(a) and (c), and OAR 848-010-0044 (3).
2. Applicant stipulates to the assessment of a civil penalty and agrees to pay the civil penalty provided in this Stipulated Agreement and Final Order.
3. The Board agrees to grant Applicant a physical therapy license.
4. Applicant agrees and understands that any further violations could result in further disciplinary action.
5. Applicant is aware of her right to notice, to be represented by counsel, to a hearing where she could call witnesses and cross-examine witnesses called by the Board, and the Applicant hereby waives these rights and agrees to entry of this Stipulated Agreement and Final Order.

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Applicant's application for a license as a physical therapist is approved and licensure is granted.
2. Applicant is publicly reprimanded.
3. Applicant is assessed a civil penalty of \$250.00 payable to the Board within 30 days of the execution of this document.
4. Any violation of the statutes or administrative rules, after notice and hearing, may result in disciplinary action, up to and including revocation of the license.
