STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND
FINAL ORDER

The Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, disciplining and regulating the practice of physical therapy in the State of Oregon pursuant to ORS 688.140 and 688.160. Eli Lambert (Applicant) is applying to the Board for a license to practice as a physical therapist (PT) in Oregon.

The Board and Licensee agreed to resolve all of the issues raised through this Stipulated Agreement and Final Order (Stipulation).

STIPULATIONS

1. Applicant stipulates that on his initial application for licensure in Oregon, dated August 23, 2002, he failed to disclose that he held a license under investigation in Hawaii. His failure to disclose is a violation of in violation of ORS 688.140(2)(j) (2002) renumbered as 688.140 (2)(c) and OAR 848-045-0020(2)(a).

2. Applicant stipulates that on November 14, 2007, he applied to the Board to reinstate his license which had lapsed on March 31, 2003. On that application, he failed to disclose disciplinary action taken in December, 2003 against his Florida physical therapy license. His failure to disclose is a violation of ORS 688.140 (2)(c) and OAR 848-045-0020(2)(a).

3. Applicant is aware of his right to notice, to be represented by counsel, to a hearing where he should call witnesses and cross-examine witnesses called by the Board, and the Applicant hereby waives these rights and agrees to entry of this Stipulation and Final Order.

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ORDER

1. The application for a license as a physical therapist in Oregon is granted and he is placed on probation for two years on the condition that the Board reserves the right to review his practice during the probationary period.
2. The applicant is assessed a civil penalty of \$500 payable upon execution of this document by the Board Executive Director.
3. By April 26, 2009, the applicant is to provide evidence to the Board of completion of the American Physical Therapy Association's course on professionalism as ordered by the State of Washington, Board of Physical Therapy.
