WHEREAS, Bonita Jo Favero (licensee) is licensed by the Physical Therapist Licensing Board (Board) as a physical therapist assistant having been issued license No. 7686; and

WHEREAS, the licensee submitted an application to renew her license dated February 12, 2002 in which she denied having been convicted of any law violation since the time of her last license renewal, in which she denied having abused alcohol and in which she denied having been treated for alcohol abuse since the time of her last license renewal; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2001 the licensee drove a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicants with a blood alcohol level of .20; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2002 the licensee attended an orientation session with Northwest Treatment, her court ordered DUII diversion treatment program; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2002 the licensee came to the Board's office and disclosed her conviction and her treatment program with Northwest Treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Board is prepared to initiate disciplinary proceedings pursuant ORS 688.140(2)(j); and

WHEREAS, the Board and the licensee are desirous of resolving these matters without further proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the licensee is aware of her right to a formal notice, to a hearing at which she may be represented by counsel, to cross-examine witnesses and present evidence in her own behalf and the right to appeal any adverse decision to the Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the licensee voluntarily waives these rights:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The licensee shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000, which is stayed on the condition that the licensee successfully complete the terms of probation provided in this Consent Order.

2. The licensee is placed on probation until August 31, 2003 under the following conditions:

a. The licensee shall not consume alcohol and she shall not consume any controlled substance or mood altering drug, unless prescribed by a practitioner for a legitimate medical condition;

b. The licensee shall attend Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) each week;

c. The licensee shall submit a written report to the Board every three months describing her employment and her recovery and she shall attach proof of attendance at AA; and

d. The licensee shall comply with all laws and rules applicable to physical therapy practice.

3. Violation of the provisions of this Consent Order may result in the Board taking further disciplinary action, after notice and hearing. Disciplinary action may include imposition of the

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stayed civil penalty and any other sanction authorized by law, including license revocation.
