

PacifiCorp Proposed Standard of Conduct

“Affiliate” means an ESS that is an Affiliated Interest of the Company, as defined in ORS 757.015.

1. Comparable Access

To the extent permissible under Federal law, the Company will provide to Consumers and ESSs access to its transmission facilities and distribution system comparable to that provided for its own use.

2. Fair Treatment of Competitors

Delivery Services will be provided and restored equitably by the Company, without regard to who supplies electricity to the Consumer.

The Company will not provide any undue preference to a Consumer that purchases electricity from an Affiliate. Company employees will not state or imply to any potential customer of an Affiliate, or to any other person, that such preference would be available. All Consumers, regardless of their Electricity Services Supplier, will receive a comparable level of distribution service.

If a tariff provision allows for discretion in its application, the Company shall apply that tariff provision in the same manner to an Affiliate and customers of an Affiliate as to other market participants and their customers. The Company will strictly enforce tariff provisions that allow no discretion in application.

The Company will not condition or tie the provision of any regulated service or rate agreement to the provision of any product or service in which an Affiliate is involved.

3. Inquiries Related to Suppliers

For Consumers requesting such information, the Company will provide a list of ESSs eligible to provide electricity services in the Company’s service territory. The list will be presented in a neutral format that does not unfairly emphasize an affiliated ESS. The Company will endeavor to update its lists periodically, but the Company is under no obligation to assure the accuracy of these lists.

4. Name and Logo

The Company and an Affiliate that shares the same name and logo will disclose to Consumers the relationship between the Company and Affiliate and state that the Affiliate is not the same as the Company and that in order to receive services from the Company, a Consumer does not have to purchase the services of the Affiliate.

5. Confidential Information

The Company will process all similar requests for consumer information in the same manner and within the same period of time.

The Company will not allow an Affiliate access to any non-public information regarding the distribution system, Electricity Services Suppliers, or Consumers that is not made available to non-affiliated Electricity Services Suppliers upon request. The Company will instruct all of its employees not to provide preferential access to non-public information to an Affiliate or to any non-affiliated ESS.

The Company will not share with an Affiliate or any non-affiliated ESS (1) any market information pertaining to Consumers' purchases of electricity that was acquired from any other Electricity Services Supplier.

The Company will not release any proprietary Consumer information without the prior written or other approved authorization of the Consumer.

If there is a charge for providing Consumer information to an ESS, the charge for like information will be the same for all ESSs.

6. Cross Subsidies Prohibited

The Company will not subsidize competitive operations at the expense of regulated operations.

7. Separation

Utility employees shall either (1) be physically separated from employees of an Affiliate; or (2) exercise security measures over documents and computer systems similar to those measures required by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission under the Company's Transmission Standards of Conduct. In addition, employees of an Affiliate shall not have access to customer information on the systems of the utility.

8. Affiliate

The Company will not act as an Electricity Services Supplier except through an Affiliate.
