**SUBJECT:** PACIFIC POWER AND LIGHT: (Advice No. 02-014) Updates tariff list of special contracts to remove expired contracts.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

I recommend that the Commission allow Pacific Power and Light Company's Advice No. 02-014 to go into effect on May 9, 2002.

**DISCUSSION:**

Pacific Power and Light Company (Pacific) filed Advice No. 02-014 with the OPUC on April 9, 2002, under ORS 757.205. The filing updates Pacific's Schedule 400 (*Special Contracts*).

Schedule 400 provides a summary description of the provisions contained in special contracts which the Company has negotiated with large nonresidential customers under OAR 860-22-0035. While most of Pacific's special rate discount contracts have expired, the following two special contracts remain effective:

1. Wah Chang, Millersburg, Oregon. This is a five-year contract that will terminate on September 12, 2002. The contract's last two years provide Wah Chang with market-based pricing.
2. James River, Camas, Washington. This is a 20-year contract that will remain in effect until October 1, 2013. The agreement provides for Pacific to own a cogeneration facility at the Customer's site. James River receives service from Pacific under Schedule 48 (*Delivery Service*) and Schedule 200 (*Cost-Based Supply Service*).
