**SUBJECT:** PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC: (Advice No. 05-1) Modifies street lighting schedules to update seasonal definitions and adds luminaire and pole options.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

I recommend that the Commission allow Portland General Electric (PGE) Advice No. 05-1 to become effective March 30, 2005.

**DISCUSSION:**

On February 4, 2005, PGE filed Advice No. 05-1 to be effective March 30, 2005. The filing was made in accordance with ORS 757.205, Filing Schedules with the Commission. On February 11, 2005, PGE filed replacement sheets to correct the HADCO Capitol Acorn luminaire monthly rate that was originally filed.

This filing updates the annual seasonal definitions and adds additional luminaire and pole options.

PGE's 2005 summer and winter billing seasons begin with the first cycle meter reading date for May and November billing months. Dates are revised to reflect the first cycle meter reading days consistent with PGE's 2005 meter reading schedule.

Additionally, PGE is removing the decoration lighting series because no customers have signed up and the three light options have not attracted any interest from customers. However, the holiday lighting series will remain a service option.

There are two minor price changes as follows:

1. The first being HADCO Techtra Ornamental Non-fluted 18-foot pole had to be repriced because the manufacturer's pole cost no longer includes the mast-arm, which is now priced separately. There is no revenue impact to Schedule 15 because no units are installed in the field. There are 140 Schedule 91 Option B poles that will experience a \$0.05 per month increase affecting three customers.
2. The second involves HADCO Techtra QL, 165-watt light fixture repriced due to a manufacturer lamp cost increase. There are 36 Schedule 91 Option B lights impacted by this change affecting one customer.

**PROPOSED COMMISSION MOTION:**

PGE's Advice No. 05-1 be allowed into effect on March 30, 2005.
