SUBJECT: IDAHO POWER COMPANY: (Advice No. 05-19) Extends the Energy House Calls for Manufactured Homes through September 30, 2006.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

I recommend that the Commission allow Idaho Power Company's Advice No. 05-19 to go into effect on December 21, 2005.

DISCUSSION:

Idaho Power Company (IPCo) filed Advice No. 05-19 with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) on November 14, 2005, under ORS 757.205.¹ The filing requests an extension of the Company's *Energy House Calls for Manufactured Homes Program* through September 30, 2006. This is a Schedule 87 program and is funded by the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) Conservation & Renewables Discount Program (C&RD).

The Energy House Calls Program offers, at no charge to the qualifying manufactured home customer, a heating duct system inspection and leak repair, as well as three compact fluorescent light bulbs, two air filters, a water heater temperature check, and energy efficiency educational information. IPCo indicates that it has reviewed the program and determined that customer demand and C&RD funding are sufficient to continue program work through September 30, 2006.
