SUBJECT: SPRINT/UNITED TELEPHONE CO OF THE NORTHWEST:
(Advice No. OR05-28) Introduces Auxiliary Listings as non-chargeable, supplemental listings available to residential and business customers who subscribe to more than one access line under a single bill.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the filing be allowed to go into effect.

DISCUSSION:

On November 17, 2005, Sprint/United Telephone Company of the Northwest filed Advice No. OR05-28. The filing introduces Auxiliary Listings into the company's tariff, PUC OR No. 3. The purpose of the filing is to standardize the company's Oregon tariff with the company's tariffs throughout its operating territory. The filing has no impact on existing customers. The filing has no annual revenue effect since the Auxiliary Listings are non-chargeable listings.

Auxiliary Listings, which provide supplemental business or residence information, will be provided without charge upon customer request. The number of supplemental listings cannot exceed the number of access lines billed under a single bill.

The filing is consistent with Oregon Revised Statute 759.190, which requires a utility to file proposed tariff changes 30 days prior to the time they are to take effect and with Oregon Administrative Rule 860-032-0025, which permits a utility to make tariff changes and establishes the type of information a utility must submit with a tariff filing. The filing is not contrary to the public interest.
