SUBJECT: OREGON PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION STAFF: Request to cancel certificates of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon of carriers who violated the terms and conditions of their certificates.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the certificates of authority to provide telecommunications services for the competitive providers listed below be cancelled.

DISCUSSION:

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 759.020 authorizes the Commission to grant certificates of authority to telecommunications competitive providers who intend to provide telecommunications service in Oregon. The Commission grants certificates with conditions. One is ORS 759.425, which requires them to comply with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements. Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-032-0014(4)(b) and OAR 860-032-0008, failure to comply with applicable statutes and rules can result in cancellation of the companies' authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon.

The following competitive providers have not complied with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements. ORS 756.514(4) provides that the Commission may, after investigation, but without hearing, make such findings and orders as deemed justified by the results of their investigation. As a result of not complying with Commission rules and terms of their certificates, the following competitive providers should have their certificates of authority to provide telecommunication service in Oregon cancelled.
