**SUBJECT:** SUNRIVER WATER LLC: (Advice No. 07-10) Revises 3/4-inch meter size to 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter size.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the Commission approved Sunriver Water LLC (Sunriver) First Revised Sheet No. 3 and First Revised Sheet No. 5. The current tariffs list a 5/8 x 3/4 inch meter as a 3/4 inch meter. The revision changes the tariffs to list the meter as a 5/8 x 3/4 inch meter, with less than statutory notice.

**DISCUSSION:**

On March 28, 2007, Sunriver filed a tariff revision to First Revised Sheet No. 3 and First Revised Sheet No. 5. The revision to the two tariff sheets changes the listing of a 3/4 inch meter to indicate the size to be 5/8 x 3/4 inch. The revisions are simply housekeeping in nature.

On April 6, 2007, Sunriver filed replacement tariffs to correct the name of the tariff book (Oregon PUC No. 6) and the effective date from January 1, 2007 to April 25, 2007. The revision to the listing of the meters remained the same. On April 18, 2007, Sunriver faxed a less than statutory notice to PUC and federal expressed the original to PUC.

In the water industry, most residential meters are 5/8 x 3/4 inch. These meters have been referred to 3/4 inch meters or 5/8 x 3/4 inch meters. In Sunriver's tariffs, the meter size is listed only as a 3/4 inch meter. Although the size of meter is the same, Sunriver desired its tariffs to be accurate and consistent with other regulated water utility tariffs. The revision changes the listing on the tariff sheets from a 3/4 inch meter to a 5/8 x 3/4 meter.
