

The Commission previously allocated local exchange telecommunications service territory to St. Paul in an order issued in 1987. Staff reviewed the Commission's records to identify all St. Paul territory allocation orders issued prior to January 1, 2006, and currently in effect. Staff then determined that St. Paul's approved local exchange map is encompassed in whole or in part by the metes and bounds description in this previous territory allocation order.

St. Paul has a Commission-approved map on file for the company's local exchange, St. Paul. Staff concluded that St. Paul's map is wholly or partially within the metes and bounds description in the company's previous territory allocation order.

On August 30, 2007, Staff sent St. Paul a letter describing staff's conclusions in detail, and asking St. Paul to make corrections, if any, by September 20, 2007. St. Paul confirmed staff's basic conclusion regarding the relationship between the previous territory allocation order and the approved local exchange map.

Table 1 describes reallocation for St. Paul in detail. Reallocations are identified by exchange name and the effective date of the corresponding Commission-approved exchange map. Previous allocation is identified by Commission order number.
