

**RULE SUMMARY**

The Health Professional's Service Program is the impaired health professional program established by the Oregon Health Authority pursuant to ORS 676.190. These rules provide a framework for the Board of Pharmacy's participation in the Program and establish a procedure for the Board to refer licensees to the program. The rules also specify a process for the Board to approve an independent evaluator and set requirements that must be met by participants.

Need for the Temporary Rule(s):


