### Summary

This agency's measures fully meet five basic criteria as outlined in the guidelines. Seven performance measures are aligned with three goals and a mission statement. They address the agency's scope of responsibility with a few key measures, all measures have targets and data sources are provided. Data are available for only three of the seven measures.
