OREGON DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION – PLANNING AND PROJECTS MANAGER RECOGNIZED AS AIRPORT MANAGER OF THE YEAR

Heather Peck, Planning and Projects Manager for the Oregon Department of Aviation, was recognized as the 2014 Airport Manager of the Year by the Oregon Airport Management Association (OAMA) at their recent fall conference in Eugene, Oregon on October 27-28th.

The award recognizes an individual who has made significant contributions to airport safety, development and/or efficiency. Heather was recognized for her extraordinary efforts managing the Agency's Capital Improvement Program as well as her leadership and professionalism managing the Agency's construction projects and statewide programs that work to support and enhance the Oregon system of Airports.

The Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) is the agency responsible for managing the statewide modal transportation system plan for aviation in the state. The ODA owns and operates 28 public use airports throughout the state of Oregon and manages statewide aviation programs and initiatives to support its mission of enhancement and promotion of aviation. The ODA is represented by a total of 12 fulltime employees with a director who reports to the 7 member Oregon Aviation Board appointed by the Governor.
