- Aviation as an Industry Cluster – how does it fit into the state of Oregon’s priorities
 - Jobs and Innovation –
 - Living wage jobs; average salary \$62,395
 - Over 400 Aviation businesses in Oregon
 - High tech jobs – manufacturing, UAS industry, skilled mechanics
 - Examples
 - Oregon has 90% of heavy lift helicopters in US.
 - VAN’s aircraft – Aurora based; top kit aircraft manufacturer in the world (makes the “RV” line of kit built aircraft).
 - Lektro, Inc. - Astoria based; makes electric aircraft tugs sold worldwide.
 - Oregon Aero – Scappoose based; manufactures aviation equipment for military.
 - Garmin – Salem based; manufacturer of GPS navigation equipment.
 - NW UAV - McMinnville based; largest manufacturer of UAS engines in U.S.
 - Education – trained work force panel discussion hits this one.
 - Universities (OSU) – Unmanned Aerial Systems/ High Tech Aviation engineering
 - Community colleges? Central Oregon CC, PCC Rock Creek, Lane college
 - Cooperative learning with aviation industry in the shops/businesses
- Airport Development
 - \$82 million from CONNECTOREGON
 - Leveraged \$251 million in Federal Grants for infrastructure improvement (50% of all ConnectOregon leveraged funds due to 90-10 FAA grant-sponsor match)
 - \$289 million in FAA grants from 2009-2011 in Oregon
 - No tax dollars (from Federal Aviation Trust Fund/user fees)
 - Port of Portland data? Projects?
- Port of Portland’s role as an economic catalyst for the state. Good opportunity to put forth POPs contributions to aviation in the state and tie it to aviation industry in the state.
- Air Service, transportation hub, satellite businesses, multimodal influence, etc.
- As Introductory speaker, we plan to have a “Kodak moment” and announce and read Aviation Proclamation signed by Governor designating October as Aviation Month in Oregon
