WHAT THE LAW SAYS

(1) Under OAR 918-282-0170(1)(b), a general journeyman electrician shall work under the supervision, direction and control of a general supervising electrician unless doing the type of work that may be supervised, directed or controlled by a person holding a specific limited supervising electrician license.

STIPULATED AGREEMENT

6 Respondent and the Board agrees to resolve this matter, without a hearing, with
7 the entry of this Consent Order subject to the following terms and conditions:

8 (1) The Board hereby assesses a civil penalty against you of \$ a \$2,000 civil
9 penalty for violating OAR 918-282-0170(1)(b), but suspends \$750 of the civil penalty
assessed for a period of five years under the following terms:

10 (1.1) Respondent agrees to pay the remaining \$1,250 of the civil penalty.

11 ***(1.2) If Respondent is able to submit a full payment of \$750 by the***
12 ***invoice due date, an additional \$500 will be suspended. The***
13 ***invoice will be included with your copy of the Final Order after it is***
signed by the Board.

14 (2) Respondent agrees if a final order is issued by the Board finding Respondent
15 violated any of Building Codes Division's statutes or rules, within five years from the
16 date this Order was signed by the Board, Respondent will pay any subsequent penalty
and the suspended penalty from this Order.

17 (3) Respondent agrees not to commit further violations of Building Codes
Division's statutes or rules.

18 (4) Respondent understands that if the respondent fails to comply with any of the
19 terms of this consent agreement that the entire civil penalty, including the amount
20 suspended, will be immediately due and payable. Failure to comply includes failure to
21 pay the civil penalty amount on the Final Demand Notice by the due date, or failure to
make payments according to the terms of any payment arrangement or Final Demand
Notice.

22 (5) Respondent understands and agrees any violation of the terms of this
Consent Order will result in further enforcement action.

23 (6) Respondent understands and agrees that any violations of Building Code
24 Division's statutes or rules not alleged in this Order, whether committed before or after
25 the execution of this Consent Order, shall be the basis for further enforcement action.


1 (7) Respondent understands the suspended civil penalty will be waived five
2 years after the execution of this Consent Order, provided Respondent complies with its
3 terms and has not committed any further violations of Building Codes Division's statutes
4 or rules.

4 (8) Respondent has read and fully understands the terms of this Consent Order,
5 freely and voluntarily consents to the entry of this Order without further hearing, without
6 any force or duress, and expressly waives all rights to a hearing or appeal in this matter.

6 (9) Respondent understands that, upon signature of all parties, this Consent
7 Order will be a FINAL ORDER.

8 (10) Respondent further agrees by signing this Consent Order that Respondent is
9 the Respondent or authorized representative for the Respondent in this matter.
