**CONCLUSION OF LAW**

1. Respondent failed to comply with the terms of the Final Order on Default by failing to make payment of the \$3,000 in civil penalties in case number C2014-0095.
  2. By failing to comply with the Final Order in BCD case C2014-0095, Respondent's general supervising electrician license 4680S may be revoked under ORS 455.129(2)(b).

**ORDER**

Under ORS 455.129(2)(b), the Electrical and Elevator Board revokes Respondent's general supervising electrician license 4680S for violating the Final Order in case number C2014-0095. General supervising electrician license 4680S will remain revoked until Respondent becomes current with the civil penalties due in BCD case C2014-0095.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

Respondent is entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon Revised Statutes, chapter 183. If Respondent requests a hearing, the request must be in writing and postmarked no later than 20 days from the service date. If this notice was served to Respondent in person, the service date is the date Respondent received this notice. If this notice was served through the mail, the service date is the day the notice was mailed, not the day Respondent received it.

If a request for hearing is not received by the Building Codes Division (division) with a postmark dated within 20 days, Respondent's rights to a hearing is considered waived. Mail hearing requests to Building Codes Division, Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

Respondent has the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides that a corporation may be represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If Respondent requests a hearing, Respondent will be notified of the time and place of the hearing and be given information on procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the hearing before it begins.



## NOTICE OF FINAL ORDER

If Respondent does not timely request a hearing, withdraws a hearing request, does not notify the Building Codes Division or the administrative law judge that Respondent will not appear, or fails to appear at a scheduled hearing, the division will issue a Final Order by Default. If the division issues a Final Order by Default, it designates the file, including any materials submitted by Respondent that relate to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a prima facie case.

Respondent is entitled to judicial review of any final order issued in the matter of this Notice of Proposed Revocation of General Supervising Electrician License Number 4680S. Judicial review may be obtained by filing a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the Final Order is served. See ORS 183.482. If the Final Order was served in person, the service date is the date Respondent received the order. If the Final Order was served through the mail, the service date is the day the order was mailed, not the day it was received by Respondent. If Respondent does not file a petition for judicial review within 60 days, Respondent will lose the right to appeal. The phone number for the Oregon Court of Appeals is 503-986-5555.
