- 2) The division will review your application for required qualification. Be sure your application includes all required additional documents. An incomplete application will slow the application process. If the application is approved, the division will notify the applicant and mail the exam to the chosen proctor.

#### IMPORTANT APPLICATION INFORMATION

- Application fees are nonrefundable.
- Before you may be approved for any Oregon Code Certification, you must have an active Oregon Inspector Certification.
- You must pass the exam with a score of 75 percent or higher.
- For the purposes of this application, one year of experience is 2,000 hours.
- This application is not for registration for the division's board-approved residential electrical inspector practicum or the residential plumbing inspector practicum.
