**STIPULATED FINAL ORDER
ASSESSING CIVIL PENALTIES**

Case No. 2010-14

STIPULATION

1.

The Board of Licensed Social Workers (Board) is the agency responsible for licensing, regulating, and disciplining Licensed Clinical Social Workers in the State of Oregon.

2.

At all times material herein, Cheryl A. Calderon, LCSW, License No. L2914 (Respondent), was a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) in the State of Oregon and subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

3.

The Board opened an investigation of Respondent after receiving a complaint that alleged that the Respondent engaged in conduct in violation of Board rules.

4.

The Board finds and Respondent admits to one violation of OAR 877-030-0040(2)[2005] in connection with failing to disclose information on her 2007 licensure renewal application, and a failure to report in January 2010, in violation of OAR 877-030-0040(2)(a)(D)[2010].

5.

Respondent desires to resolve this matter through issuance of this Stipulated Final Order Assessing Civil Penalties.

6.

Respondent stipulates, agrees, understands, and acknowledges as follows:

6.1 Respondent as part of the issuance of this Order is assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$500.00 for each of the 2 violations described above for a total of \$1,000.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to ORS 675.540(2)(c) and 675.595(9) [2009] and other applicable authority.

6.2 The payment of the civil penalties under the terms of this Order in the sum of \$1000.00 is due and payable within Thirty (30) days of issuance of this Order.

6.3 This Order is subject to and conditional upon acceptance and approval by the full Board. If accepted by the full Board, the Order is effective upon issuance.

6.4 This Order is a public document and a matter of public discipline, pursuant to ORS 675.540 and other applicable authority. This document must be disclosed, published and reported in accordance with ORS 676.175(5)(a)(D), OAR 877-040-0050, and Oregon Public Records Law.


6.5 Any violation of the terms of this Order shall be grounds for disciplinary action under ORS 675.540 and other applicable authority. The Board has the right to take action against Respondent to enforce this Order, for any violation thereof, or for other violations of ORS 675.510 to 675.600 or OAR Chapter 877 not stated herein.

6.6 As part of the consideration for entering into this Order, the Board will not assess against Respondent the costs of this disciplinary process, including the Board's legal costs.

6.7 Respondent has fully read this Order and understands it completely. Respondent has consulted with an attorney regarding this Order and has been fully advised in regards thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this stipulation and issuance of this Order.

6.8 Respondent enters into this Order voluntarily and without any force or duress. Respondent states that no promises or representation not stated herein have been made to induce Respondent to sign this stipulation and agree to issuance of this Order.

6.9 Respondent understands that she has the right to notice and a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (ORS Chapter 183) and Civil Penalty Procedures of ORS 183.745, and fully and finally waives any and all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Order.
