U.S. Department of Labor estimates that nearly 7 million jobs in the construction industry will need to be filled by 2024.

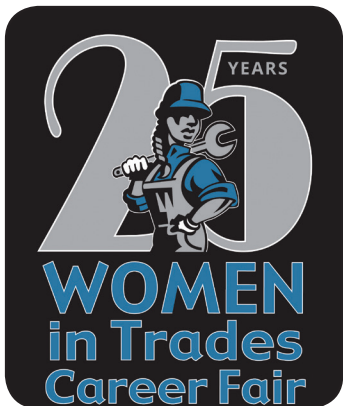
