REGARDING: Proposed Administrative Rule Amendment

On July 14, 2016, the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) filed with the Oregon Secretary of State a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking pertaining to rules which regulate the contents of wage statements. The proposed rule amendments would conform the requirements of OAR 839-020-0012 (Wage Statements to Be Provided to Employees) and OAR 839-020-0083 (Records Availability) in the minimum wage rules to related provisions in SB 1587, which take effect on January 1, 2017.
