**REGARDING:** Proposed Rule filed regarding Agency Response to Objections regarding Investigative Subpoenas

On February 22, 2015, the Bureau filed with the Oregon Secretary of State a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking. The proposed amendment to OAR 839-002-0065 would clarify regarding the agency's procedure for dealing with objections to investigative subpoenas and provide flexibility to the agency in responding to objections. With this Memo are the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Statement of Need and text of the proposed amendment.

The proposed amendment has been in effect since January 5, 2015 as a temporary rule. The proposed amendment would supersede the temporary rule on the date the proposed rule becomes final, which is expected to be April 12, 2015.<sup>1</sup>

Public comments on the proposed rule will be accepted through 5 pm on March 30, 2015.
